For Students from Connecticut

Eligibility: Graduating high school seniors from the State of Connecticut.

This memo contains information for applying to the United States Junior Chamber International (JCI) Senate Foundation Scholarship Program. Each year \$1,000 grants will be awarded to graduating high school seniors in the United States, who plan to continue their education at accredited post-secondary colleges, universities or vocational schools. The number of grants awarded annually will be at the discretion of the United States JCI Senate Foundation. They must be used for educational expenses in the first year of full-time study. Checks awarded will be made out in the name of the recipient and the educational institution of their choice.

Note: the Connecticut JCI Senate awards up to two \$500 scholarship(s) AND the selected winner(s) are also submitted to the US JCI Senate Foundation for consideration for the \$1000 grants.

- * Reference letters are limited to three (3) with a maximum length of one (1) page each.
- * Your application must be postmarked no later than January 5, 2018.
