Gift cards are available from Starbucks, Home Depot, Best Buy, Walmart, Target, Kohl's and a host of others just to name a few. Purchase these cards and use them for your everyday purchases and help the Senate at the same time. The holidays are coming. What an easier way to complete your shopping list! Remember you can always pay RaiseRight by Credit Card.

But if you want to

use Venmo to pay for Raise Right gift card purchases simply shop for the gift cards you want. When finished, go to "Cart" and pay for purchase or Select "Pay the Coordinator". You will get a message stating your purchase is in process. Your purchase will be approved by a Senate coordinator when your Venmo payment is received. YOU MUST GO TO VENMO SEPARATELY TO SEND THE PAY-MENT.

We suggest you select an "e-gift card" or "ship to home" gift card. If you select a "ship to organization" for gift card the CT JCI Senate will incur a \$10.50 handling fee. So, we will need to collect that from you prior to approval of order.

The name of the account in Venmo is-JACK PASQUALE@CTJCI-SENATE

The first time you use the account to send money to the CT JCI Senate, Venmo will ask for the last four digits of the phone number associated with the account. This code is 2517. You should get a confirmation message that says you have selected the proper entity.

Next go ahead and send the amount you wish to pay. In the notes section put in a few words to let the Senate know what the money's for (i.e., dues; donation; Raise Right gift cards; registration; etc.) If you have any questions or issues with Venmo, contact Jack at <u>ctjcisenate@gmail.com</u>
