FROM THE TREASURER



Is it just me, or does the time seem to fly by for everyone? As we end one senate year we look back at the memories and look forward to collecting new ones in our new senate year which started July 1.

Congratulations to Bonnie Blaisdell, Senator 69956 on her election as the Connecticut JCI Senate president for 2024-2025. Rounding out the new board is Vice-president Michele Tarantino, Senator 63380, Treasurer Jack Pasquale, Senator 32806, and COB Marybeth Kaczynski, Senator 67636. We are looking forward to other senators stepping forward to be on Bonnie's "Better Together" team.

Thank you, thank you, thank you to Peter Falk, Senator 38891, and Lou Blumenfeld, Senator 49713, for your generous donations to the General Fund, and your support of the Connecticut JCI Senate.

The CT JCI Senate budget for 2024-2025 was adopted at the summer picnic social and budget meeting on July 20, 2024 at the VFW hall in Niantic. Please see the approved budget elsewhere in this newsletter.

Looking back over the year I am happy to report our State of Connecticut Annual Business report was filed on February 9, 2024, well in advance of the March 5, 2024, deadline, and we received a confirmation letter that our business filing has been accepted. Failure of a business to timely file the report is subject to administrative dissolution.

As a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt organization, we are required to make an annual filing with the IRS to maintain our tax-exempt status. The filing must be made by the 15th day of the 5th month after the close of our tax year. Our tax year ended December 31, 2023 and the necessary Form 990-N (e-Postcard) filing was made, Tuesday, August 27, 2024 and its acceptance was confirmed.

Our September 1, 2024 quarterly dues billings to the US JCI Senate were timely filed and paid. Thank you and a shout out for the cooperation of the 23 members due for the 1st quarter billing cycle paying their dues early. We currently have 121 members.

Our Raise Right program continues to generate funds for the Senate. If you haven't signed up yet to take advantage of the ease to purchase gift cards and help the Senate, just
